



Safeguarding Training Parents and All Volunteers

The training is simple to complete and will help all of us to understand what to do if you believe a child or young person is being harmed, and to make sure you are doing all you can to prevent this from happening.

It will also confirm what our obligations are to comply with DECYP policies and procedures, and with the new laws designed to better safeguard children and young people in Tasmania.

All volunteers and service providers must complete the training before working with any children or young people this year.

Who is required to complete the training?

The Child and Youth Safe Organisations Act 2023 states that all “workers” are required to complete the training. “Workers” include all DECYP employees, External Service Providers and **Volunteers**.

Volunteers include parent help in classrooms, parents attending excursions,
